Dealer East: None vul.
Lead: ♠8

West	East

♣ 6	♣ KJ4

South made a weak jump overcall of 2♠ over partner's opening of 1♦. Dummy has 13 points, but is very disappointing opposite your hand. You'll need some help from the defense on this one. Thoughts? See more on page 3.

Events Information

Costs Per Session:

All ACBL players with less than 5 masterpoints play for free. For all other paid-up ACBL members, the fee is \$11 per session. For non ACBL members and unpaid-up ACBL players, the fee is \$13 per session.

Bracketed Knockouts:

Brackets are drawn up based on the total masterpoints of all members of the team. The team captain will enter by submitting a registration form on which he has designated the number of players and the total masterpoints. A player with non ACBL rating points is obligated to declare them at the time of entry, and the director will look up the conversion rate before assigning a bracket for the team.

Once the brackets have been drawn, it is too late to enter or withdraw a team.

If there are more than four players on the team, they are all expected to play. If there is a non-bridge reason why a player must miss an entire early match, the team must ask for permission, and the player who has missed a match must play the entire next match (even if he played an entire earlier one). Every player must play at least half of the 3rd and 4th matches.

Bracketed Knockouts with less than 3 brackets will be handicapped.

The Compact Knockouts on Tuesday, Friday/Saturday evenings, and Saturday are limited to teams of exactly four players by ACBL policy.

Side Series Pairs:

The Side Series Pairs will be held as three separate events: Morning, Afternoon, and Evening. If attendance at any Side Series is not warranted, players can be folded into other pairs events for one session. You may play in as many sessions as you like and with different partners. Your best two individual sessions during the same time frame will determine your place in the overalls for that time frame. For example, the results of your best two Morning sessions will be used to determine your place in the Morning overalls.

Friday Bridge Hand Cont.

You have problems in both black suits and diamonds. Your first decision is whether or not to rise with the ♠Q on trick 1. However, given the bidding and the lead this appears to be highly improbable; if North has led away from the king, then give him full marks for a tough lead. Thus placing both spade honors with South you insert the 7 and South plays the jack as expected which you win with your ace. Ducking won't gain unless you get to dummy and South foolishly covers one of your spade honors.

You draw trumps and decide what to do next. It now seems logical to set up a spade for a club discard in case South misguesses what to do after winning the king. Sure enough South wins the king and elects to return a spade on which you discard your losing club. That's one hurdle, but you still have to guess how to handle diamonds. This is one

of the rare cases where you are hoping for a 4-1 break, but only if one player has the stiff jack or queen. From the bidding, South is more likely to be short, having already shown 8 cards in the majors. So after laying down the ♦A and seeing South play the queen, you pick up the diamond suit and make your slam. South might hold exactly QJ, but that is much more unlikely.
