## Events Information

### Costs Per Session:

All ACBL players with less than 5 masterpoints play for free. For all other paid-up ACBL members, the fee is \$11 per session. For non ACBL members and unpaid-up ACBL players, the fee is \$13 per session.

### Bracketed Knockouts:

Brackets are drawn up based on the total masterpoints of all members of the team. The team captain will enter by submitting a registration form on which he has designated the number of players and the total masterpoints. A player with non ACBL rating points is obligated to declare them at the time of entry, and the director will look up the conversion rate before assigning a bracket for the team.

Once the brackets have been drawn, it is too late to enter or withdraw a team.

If there are more than four players on the team, they are all expected to play. If there is a non-bridge reason why a player must miss an entire early match, the team must ask for permission, and the player who has missed a match must play the entire next match (even if he played an entire earlier one). Every player must play at least half of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> matches.

Bracketed Knockouts with less than 3 brackets will be handicapped.

The Compact Knockouts on Tuesday, Friday/Saturday evenings, and Saturday are limited to teams of exactly four players by ACBL policy.

### Side Series Pairs:

The Side Series Pairs will be held as three separate events: Morning, Afternoon, and Evening. If attendance at any Side Series is not warranted, players can be folded into other pairs events for one session. You may play in as many sessions as you like and with different partners. Your best two individual sessions during the same time frame will determine your place in the overalls for that time frame. For example, the results of your best two Morning sessions will be used to determine your place in the Morning overalls.

### Saturday Bridge Hand Cont.

All seems well at first glance, so you should stop and think about what could go wrong. Your only possible losers are in the minors, so you should focus your attention on those suits. In diamonds, you can handle any bad split because your suit is so strong; the only question is how to tackle the suit. A straightforward finesse seems appropriate since East rates to be the hand with longer diamonds. Even if the finesse loses, there is virtually no danger of a ruff by East. If West had five clubs to go with his long hearts, chances are the opponents would have interfered quite a bit more in the bidding.

When you lose a diamond trick you now turn your attention to clubs. If clubs are 3-2 you can claim, but by now you should expect them to split poorly. Do you see how you can overcome this situation? When West shows out on the first club, you should immediately think about a possible squeeze position. On this hand a textbook double squeeze emerges. You should cash the top clubs, ruff a heart, and begin running the remaining diamonds making sure to keep a heart menace in dummy.

When the final diamond is played West must pitch a spade. Now you can part with a heart in dummy and East is squeezed. When he also parts with a spade, your third spade in dummy becomes the twelfth trick. If you saw the double finesse early in the hand you could even cash the ♦A immediately for extra safety instead of taking the finesse.
