Sunday Bridge Hand

Playing in the Spingold KO teams first day qualifier you pick up: ♠QT943 ♥A632 ♦Q7 ♣K5.

Dealer East: E-W vul.

The bidding:

West	North	East	South
		1♣	1♠
?			

What do you bid as West?

If you don't think you have game, you can pass and hope to defend 1♠, hopefully doubled. With game aspirations, the options seem to be a negative double or blasting 3NT. However, with your current partner you have the fortune of playing a conventional 3♠ that transfers partner to 3NT. This puts overcaller on lead and often promotes partner's honor holding in the overcalled suit. Since this hand seems to be NT oriented, your hearts are bad, and the 9 trick game is safer, you choose 3♠ and partner complies by bidding 3NT.

Now switch to declarer's seat (East):

West	East
♠ QT943	♠ K82
♥ A632	♥ K954
♦ Q7	♦ 832
♣ K5	♣ AQ7

The lead against 3NT is the ♠6. Can you give yourself a chance to make this game? Hint: You will have to put pressure on North and hope he makes a mistake. See more on page 2.

Sunday Bridge Hand Cont.

A reasonable line is to win the ♠8 in hand and continue on spades by leading the king. North will immediately be forced to try and figure out which suits to protect. In practice, North signaled his diamond holding first with the J then the T. When South won the A of spades on trick 2 he cashed his top diamonds and allowed North to win the final round of diamonds. Now North guessed to lead the heart Q. East rose with the K felling to T. On two more spades North pitched two hearts hoping East had four clubs instead of four hearts. This decision was fatal and East scored 3 spades, 3 clubs, and 3 hearts for +600 and 12 IMPs.

This hand shows that even top level teams go astray on defense. If you chose to try and defend 1♠ N-S will run to either of their minor suit fits and you will still be stuck guessing what to do. Also, notice that 3NT by East is the only game that has any hope. 4♥ by E-W is virtually hopeless and 3NT by West will likely result in 5 immediate diamond tricks by the defense.
