Events Information

Costs Per Session:

All ACBL players with less than 5 masterpoints play for free. For all other paid-up ACBL members, the fee is \$11 per session. For non ACBL members and unpaid-up ACBL players, the fee is \$13 per session.

Bracketed Knockouts:

Brackets are drawn up based on the total masterpoints of all members of the team. The team captain will enter by submitting a registration form on which he has designated the number of players and the total masterpoints. A player with non ACBL rating points is obligated to declare them at the time of entry, and the director will look up the conversion rate before assigning a bracket for the team.

Once the brackets have been drawn, it is too late to enter or withdraw a team.

If there are more than four players on the team, they are all expected to play. If there is a non-bridge reason why a player must miss an entire early match, the team must ask for permission, and the player who has missed a match must play the entire next match (even if he played an entire earlier one). Every player must play at least half of the 3rd and 4th matches.

Bracketed Knockouts with less than 3 brackets will be handicapped.

The Compact Knockouts on Tuesday, Friday/Saturday evenings, and Saturday are limited to teams of exactly four players by ACBL policy.

Side Series Pairs:

The Side Series Pairs will be held as three separate events: Morning, Afternoon, and Evening. If attendance at any Side Series is not warranted, players can be folded into other pairs events for one session. You may play in as many sessions as you like and with different partners. Your best two individual sessions during the same time frame will determine your place in the overalls for that time frame. For example, the results of your best two Morning sessions will be used to determine your place in the Morning overalls.

Thursday Bridge Hand Cont.

Even on some beneficial layouts, best defense will almost certainly win two black suit tricks now that the entry in clubs is knocked out of dummy. Therefore, you must hope the defense will slip up.

The club lead almost certainly marks East with the KQ so that suit can be held to one loser. Spades will have to be played for two winners and no losers or else you will have to set them up for multiple discards. Your only advantage is that after using Roman Keycard, the defense will expect the North hand to have started with a singleton club. Here, after winning the ♣A, North called for the deceptive ♠T. West, perhaps thinking North had Kx, covered with the jack and allowed North to win the king. Obviously, a better play is to rise with the ace and return a club immediately. However, after this development, North played the king then ace of hearts. Then a small spade was led, upon which West rose with the ace, which was ruffed. Trumps were drawn, and the losing diamond was discarded on the ♠Q using the ♣J as an entry to dummy.

When viewing all four hands, we can see that West's play in spades was poor, but understandable. Too often when defending slams the defenders assume that declarer has the exact distribution or cards he needs. In the unlikely event that North has three spades, a hold up is required; if North has two or fewer spades rising with the ace immediately can't cost.
