Wednesday Bridge Hand

Today's hand involves bidding over a pre-empt and making a key decision with an unusually strong hand. Playing in a team game, after the following bidding sequence:

Dealer West: None vul.

West	North	East	South
P	P	2♥	?

You look down at this hand sitting South:

♠ AQ3
 ♥ A6
 ♦ AK
 ♣ AKQ762

What is your plan in the bidding? Here are some considerations:

1. East generally has a sound pre-emptive style. However, here East is in third seat and will often relax some of his usual standards.
2. Do you try for a scientific auction with partner or bid what you think you can make?
3. Does your answer change if you are ahead or behind in the match?

Events Information

Costs Per Session:

All ACBL players with less than 5 masterpoints play for free. For all other paid-up ACBL members, the fee is \$11 per session. For non ACBL members and unpaid-up ACBL players, the fee is \$13 per session.

Bracketed Knockouts:

Brackets are drawn up based on the total masterpoints of all members of the team. The team captain will enter by submitting a registration form on which he has designated the number of players and the total masterpoints. A player with non ACBL rating points is obligated to declare them at the time of entry, and the director will look up the conversion rate before assigning a bracket for the team.

Once the brackets have been drawn, it is too late to enter or withdraw a team.

If there are more than four players on the team, they are all expected to play. If there is a non-bridge reason why a player must miss an entire early match, the team must ask for permission, and the player who has missed a match must play the entire next match (even if he played an entire earlier one). Every player must play at least half of the 3rd and 4th matches.

Bracketed Knockouts with less than 3 brackets will be handicapped.

The Compact Knockouts on Tuesday, Friday/Saturday evenings, and Saturday are limited to teams of exactly four players by ACBL policy.

Side Series Pairs:

The Side Series Pairs will be held as three separate events: Morning, Afternoon, and Evening. If attendance at any Side Series is not warranted, players can be folded into other pairs events for one session. You may play in as many sessions as you like and with different partners. Your best two individual sessions during the same time frame will determine your place in the overalls for that time frame. For example, the results of your best two Morning sessions will be used to determine your place in the Morning overalls.

Wednesday Bridge Hand Cont.

It's not very often you pick up a two loser hand. Grand slam is on if partner can contribute a couple clubs and the major suit kings. Can you find out about these cards? Mathematically, partner will usually have a couple clubs, so it's reasonable to assume that with clubs as trumps you can pick up the entire suit. Additionally, East rates to have the heart king due to his opening bid. Unless you have some special methods, you probably won't be able to find out about the spade king until you've already committed yourself to a small slam.

So it seems you might as well make your stand now. If you decide to go conservatively and stay in game, you must weigh the odds. Assuming clubs are running, 3NT makes trivially. 5♣ will also make if partner has the ♠K, ♠J, or ♥K. There are also some additional layouts that will present endplay opportunities if partner has none of those cards. 5♣ will make and 3NT will fail only if clubs don't run and partner has the right specific cards. I give 3NT the slight nod because I expect clubs to run on most layouts, nine tricks are easier, and 3NT is more difficult to defend.

If you have slam ambitions, bidding 6♣ immediately has the most merit, unless you have a way to simultaneously show a strong one suiter and force partner to bid. Starting with a double will rarely get any useful information out of partner and will often put him in a bind.
